

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
Cash Receipts and Government Payments, Montana 1993 – 2008 (million 2008\$)

Payment Inflation Adjusted




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Montana Net Farm Income 1949 – 2008 (million 2008\$)




Winter Wheat Prices 1990 – 2009f




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Montana Winter Wheat Production 1990-2008




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Spring Wheat Prices 1990–2009f




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Montana Spring Wheat Production 1990-2008




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All Barley Prices 1990–2009f

Global & US Wheat Market (current situation)

World

- 2008 Wheat Production $\rightarrow 12\%$ Higher than 2007
 - Strong prices (supply response) 680 mmt (08), 603 mmt (07)
- Global Ending Wheat Stocks up from last year
 - 110 mmt in 2007 to 144.4 mmt in 2008
- - 2008 Wheat Production 21% Higher than 2007
 - US Ending Wheat Stocks up substantially

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International Trade - WheatWheat exports are expected to decline






Montana Cattle Inventory (Jan. 1)
