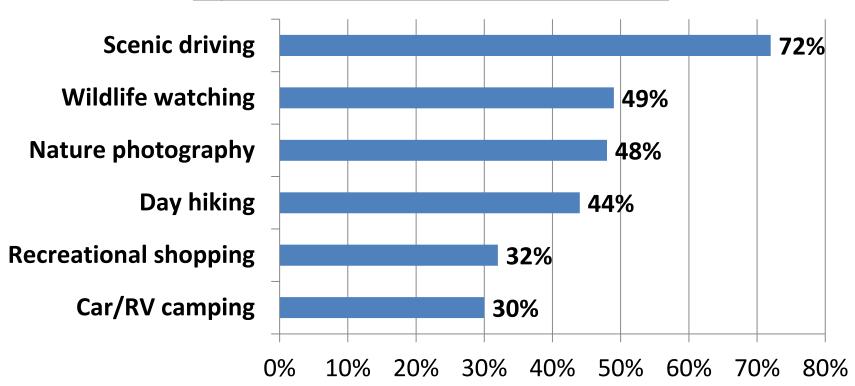

Nonresidents - By the Numbers in 2013

- 11 million nonresident visitors (+2%)
- \$3.5 billion in direct spending
- Spending up in the first 3 quarters
 - √Q1 +4% (\$151/day)
 - √Q2 +5% (\$142/day)
 - √Q3 +20% (\$162/day)

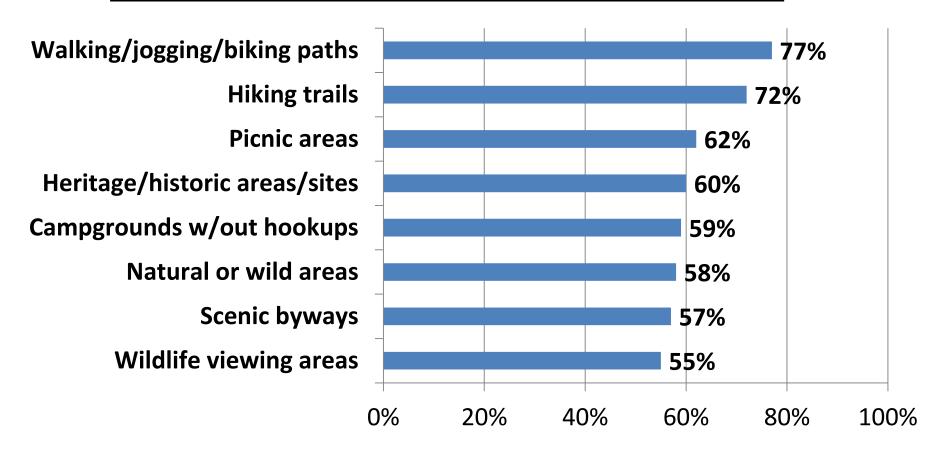

Airport deboardings down 6%



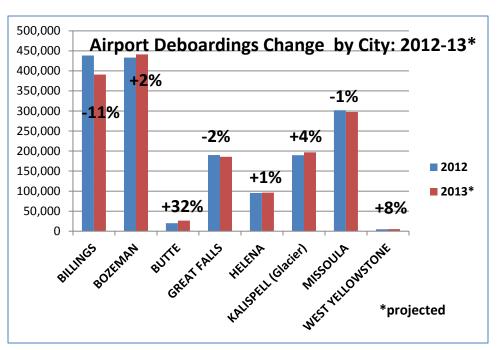
Amtrak ridership down 7%

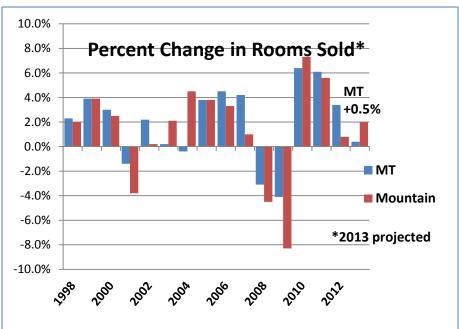


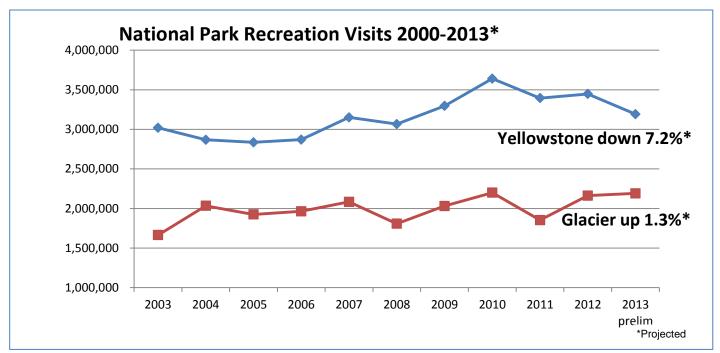

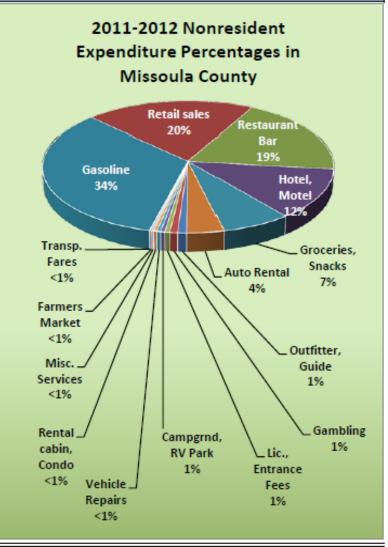


2011-2012 Nonresident Traveler Expenditures & Economic Contribution in Missoula County (in 2012 \$s)

2014
