


Real Non-Farm Earnings, Lewis and Clark County vs. Montana

Index, 2007 = 100




Growth in Real Nonfarm Earnings, Lewis and Clark County, 2014-15, Millions of Dollars

Growth in Wages Cooled in 2016










State Government:


Federal Government:




Change in Nonfarm Earnings, Lewis and Clark County, 2014-2020
