

Inflation Corrected Earnings in 2016 as Percent of 2007, Hill County





Uneven Pattern of Growth in 2016


Percent Growth in Inflation-Corrected Nonfarm Earnings


Local Government Expansion an Outlier

Inflation-Corrected Covered Wages, Index 2007=100






Outlook for Job Growth is Pessimistic






Looking Ahead to 2018
