






# MORE FACTS TO REMEMBER....

- 82% of L&C County's population lives in the Greater Helena Area
- Helena's share of Lewis & Clark County's employment & income is close to 90%
- As of Dec. 2021 Lewis and Clark county had a total of 36,942 (up 1665 from 35,277 one year ago) in our Labor Force (after being up 681 from 2019); We have 36,342 currently employed resulting in 1.6% (Dec. 31) unemployment or approx. 600 countywide that are unemployed.





In 2020 - Montana was 20<sup>th</sup> of the 50 states in growth during the pandemic and gained 10,454 residents Bankrate.com/real-estate/states-growing-most-during-pandemic/

#### Helena +6.2% (net +1860 people)



## Employment in Helena Area...








#### NEW LABOR MARKET STATS FOR HELENA


- Pre-pandemic Helena was growing by 1.1% per year & employment was growing by 0.7%
- Currently... 45% of L&C County jobs have the potential to be remote. (pandemic impact)
- 66% of our population is <u>IN</u> the labor force higher than the statewide average. (Retirement is the most common reason for not participating......61%)
- Currently licensed childcare meets only 45% of the estimated demand.

## Residential Permits

#### RESIDENTIAL - City of Helena

- 2015 301 permits = \$33.3 million
- 2016 217 permits = \$94.8 million
- 2017 232 permits = \$28.9 million
- 2018 364 permits = \$43.65 million
- 2019 316 permits = \$42.3 million
- 2020 247 permits = \$22.5 million
- 2021 251/735 permits = \$56.34 million (Incl. 394 re-roofs)

 Family Dwellings (within city limits)

- ► 394 Re-Roof permits ☺












## MEDIAN HOME SALES PRICES

## Passenger Traffic

- Helena 82% of 2019 (2021)
- Nationally air travel was down 18%
- Still working to get direct flight to
  Phoenix on American Airlines plus reinstate the Delta Minneapolis Flight & Alaska - addl. to Seattle.
  - In the past 2 years 9 multi-plane hangars Plus 5 more coming this year.
