



Wage Share Relative to U.S.









Residential Construction Has Surged in Many Markets

Residential Building Permits, 2021 and Pre-2007 Peak






Housing Permits, Montana, 2000-2022



Housing Starts, Custer County




Housing Growth and Population Growth, Custer County, 1980-2020, Percent



Change in Inflation-Corrected Total Earnings, Custer County, 2020 – 2021, (\$ Millions)




Wages and Employment, Custer County, 2019Q1 – 2022Q2
