










# Composition of Construction, Yellowstone County, 2009








Percent Change in Construction Earnings, by Component (In Constant Dollars), 2007-2009, Yellowstone County






## Actual and Projected Change in Nonfarm Earnings, Yellowstone County, 2007-2014


